HPC can help cover the costs of college through interest-free loans of up to \$2,500 per year. The loans are available for Heritage Church and other Christian students. Contact Susan Brose at <a href="mailto:sbrose.hpc@gmail.com">sbrose.hpc@gmail.com</a> for an application form. Submit applications by July 31st so the Endowment committee has time to review your application and finalize the loans before school starts.



Loans are made for \$1,250 per semester, \$2,500 per school year, for a maximum of four years and \$10,000. Loans are interest-free with a 50-month repayment schedule beginning 12 months after the final year of education concludes.


